Route 1 southbound right lane closed for emergency roadway repairs in South Brunswick, Middlesex County Expect delays through the evening commute

(Trenton) – The right lane on Route 1 southbound is closed for emergency roadway repairs between Sand Hill Road and New Road in South Brunswick, Middlesex County. Motorists should expect delays during the evening commute and are advised to consider alternate routes.

Earlier today, Tuesday, June 25, the right lane on Route 1 southbound was closed south of Sand Hill Road in South Brunswick for emergency roadway repairs. One lane remains open. Repairs will continue overnight, including milling and paving a portion of the roadway. Work is expected to be completed by 6 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, June 26. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays or plan alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
