I-295 lane closures required in both directions over the next several months in Burlington and Mercer counties Route 154 lane closures for the next several months in Camden County

(Trenton) – I-295 is scheduled to have daytime and overnight lane closures in both directions over the next several months from Route 130 in Bordentown to I-195/Route 29 in Hamilton as a maintenance roadway resurfacing project begins in Burlington and Mercer counties. In addition, Route 154 is scheduled to have overnight lane closures over the next several months from CR 561/Haddonfield-Berlin Road to Kings Highway/Route 41 in Cherry Hill, Camden County.

I-295 Daytime Lane Closures

From 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 9 and continuing daily Monday through Friday for the next several weeks, a single lane on I-295 northbound and southbound is scheduled to be closed between Route 130 and I-195/Route 29.

I-295 Overnight Lane Closures

Beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 9, until 6 a.m. Wednesday, July 10 and continuing overnight Monday through Friday at the same time over the next several months, a single lane on I-295 northbound and southbound will be closed, with a second lane closed at 9 p.m. each night, between Route 130 and I-195/Route 29.

The I-295 daytime and overnight lane closures are necessary to mill and pave, as well as restripe the roadway. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays while driving through the work zone. In addition, ramp closures may be necessary during construction. In the event of a ramp closure, motorists are advised to follow the signed detours.

Route 154 Lane Closures

Beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 9, until 6 a.m. Wednesday, July 10 and continuing overnight Monday through Friday at the same time over the next several months, a single lane on Route 154 will be closed between CR 561/Haddonfield-Berlin Road and Kings Highway/Route 41. The lane closures are necessary to mill and pave, as well as restripe the roadway. Traffic will be maintained using alternating traffic and traffic shifts. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays while driving through

the work zone. In addition, ramp closures may be necessary during construction. In the event of a ramp closure, motorists are advised to follow the signed detours.

This work is part of a \$13.8 million state funded project that will mill and pave, as well as restripe, approximately four miles of pavement on I-295 in both directions between Route 130/Route 57 in Bordentown, Burlington County to I-195/Route 29 in Hamilton, Mercer County. In addition, the maintenance roadway resurfacing project will resurface the entire length of Route 154 (approximately a mile and a half) in Cherry Hill, Camden County. Other work is expected to take place at various locations in Burlington, Camden, Gloucester, and Salem counties. This includes milling and paving, ITS installation, curb and sidewalk repairs and installation of ADA-compliant ramps. This project is expected to be completed by spring 2025.
