Route 1 lane closures for DRJTBC bridge repairs and paving in Trenton, Mercer County Daytime work for several weeks before overnight paving

(Trenton) – Route 1 is scheduled to have lane closures in both directions before the Bridge over the Delaware River into Pennsylvania for the next several weeks as the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission (DRJTBC) makes repairs to the bridge and roadway approaches between Trenton, Mercer County and Morrisville, Pennsylvania.

Beginning at 9:30 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, July 26 until 5:30 p.m., and continuing Monday through Saturday at the same time for a few weeks, DRJTBC is scheduled to close a single lane on Route 1 from east of the Route 29 interchange ramps in Trenton across the bridge to Pennsylvania Avenue in Morrisville, Pennsylvania. The closures are necessary for bridge deck sealing and concrete and median repairs. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists should use caution, slow down, and expect delays.

Work is expected to begin on Route 1 northbound in Pennsylvania moving across the bridge to New Jersey and then move to Route 1 southbound from New Jersey to Pennsylvania. Upon completion of the daytime bridge repairs in several weeks, the project will mill and pave the approaches to the bridge in both directions. Milling and paving will be done overnight. The project is expected to be completed this fall. This is a DRJTBC project, for further information please contact DRJTBC.
