Route 9 northbound lane closed for emergency water main repair in Sayreville, Middlesex County One lane remains open, second lane to be closed tonight

(Trenton) – One lane on Route 9 northbound is closed for emergency water main repairs between the Garden State Parkway and Route 35 in Sayreville, Middlesex County, and a second lane will be closed later tonight.

Beginning at approximately 3:45 p.m. today, Thursday, August 29, the right lane on Route 9 northbound was closed after the ramp to the Garden State Parkway northbound through Conlogue Avenue for emergency water main repairs near Charles Street. The ramp to the Garden State Parkway and one lane on Route 9 remain open. At 9 p.m. tonight, both lanes are scheduled to be closed with traffic getting by on the shoulder. Motorists should use caution, slow down and expect delays, or consider an alternate route. The work is expected to be completed before the morning commute tomorrow.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
