Mantua Grove Road to be closed for railroad crossing repairs beginning tomorrow in West Deptford Detours necessary during construction

(Trenton) – Mantua Grove Road is scheduled to be closed and detoured beginning tomorrow between Forest Parkway and Patsy Court for railroad crossing repairs in West Deptford, Gloucester County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. Wednesday, September 4, until 7 a.m. Saturday, September 7, Mantua Grove Road will be closed in both directions between Forest Parkway and Patsy Court (in between the Amazon driveway and Patsy Court) to remove and reconstruct the existing railroad crossing and approaches. Access will be maintained for local traffic and to all businesses within the project limits, including the Amazon Fulfillment Center. Motorists commuting to the Amazon Fulfillment Center will be able to access the center using Mantua Grove Road eastbound from I-295. The following detours will be in place:

Mantua Grove Road/Paradise Road eastbound detour:

- Traffic on Paradise Road eastbound, which becomes Mantua Grove Road eastbound will be directed turn left onto Route 44/Crown Point Road northbound
- Turn right on Mid Atlantic Parkway
- Turn right onto Grove Road, back to Mantua Grove Road

Mantua Road Grove/Parkville Road westbound detour:

- Traffic on Parkville Road westbound, which becomes Mantua Grove Road westbound, will be directed turn right onto Grove Road
- Turn left onto Mid Atlantic Parkway
- Turn left onto Route 44/Crown Point Road southbound, back to Mantua Grove Road
- For motorists commuting to the Amazon Fulfillment Center, turn left onto Mantua Grove Road eastbound

In order to provide safer and smoother railroad crossing, the existing crossing will be replaced with new concrete crossings and asphalt approaches. This federally funded project is included within NJDOT's railroad grade-crossing safety program which repairs, upgrades, or removes approximately 50 crossings each year, statewide.
