## Route 29 southbound lane closures tonight as drainage improvement project advances in Trenton Closures necessary to restripe roadway

**(Trenton)** – Route 29 southbound is scheduled to have overnight lane closures with a moving operation tonight between Calhoun Street and Cass Street in Trenton, Mercer County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 6, until 7 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 7, Route 29 southbound is scheduled to have lane closures with a moving operation between Calhoun Street and Cass Street. The closures are necessary to restripe the roadway into its final configuration. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained overnight.

The work is part of the \$29.1 million federally funded Route 29, Cass Street to Calhoun Street Drainage project in Trenton. Work includes drainage improvements, shoulder widening, new inlets, and the construction of a new flood wall. These drainage improvements will prevent backwater from the Delaware River from flooding Route 29, and the new flood wall will provide protection from river erosion. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2025.
