Route 3 lane closures in both directions tonight for sign structure removal in Secaucus Temporary 15-minute traffic stoppage to remove sign

(Trenton) – The left lanes on Route 3 eastbound and westbound are scheduled to be closed tonight to remove an overhead sign structure in Secaucus, Hudson County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, October 8 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, October 9, the left lanes of Route 3 eastbound and westbound are scheduled to be closed between the NJ Turnpike and Route 495. The closure is necessary to remove the overhead sign structure on Route 3 eastbound just before Paterson Plank Road. In addition, there will be a temporary 15-minute stoppage of Route 3 eastbound traffic on both the main line and service road during the night to remove the overhead sign truss.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
