## Route 35 northbound daily shoulder closures beginning Monday in Holmdel and Hazlet, Monmouth County Route 35 northbound right lane to be closed, if necessary

**(Trenton)** – Route 35 northbound is scheduled to have daily right shoulder closures over the next two weeks as a maintenance roadway resurfacing project begins in Holmdel and Hazlet, Monmouth County. In addition, the right lane on Route 35 northbound may be closed, where necessary, to assist with construction in the shoulder.

From 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday, October 28, and continuing daily Monday through Friday for the next two weeks, the right shoulder on Route 35 northbound is scheduled to be closed between Palmer Avenue in Holmdel and Holmdel Road in Hazlet. The closures are necessary to reset manholes.

Where needed, the right lane on Route 35 northbound will be closed between Palmer Avenue and Holmdel Road to assist with manhole repairs. If a right lane closure is necessary, it will begin at 9 a.m. and reopen at 3 p.m., daily, and at least one lane will be maintained on Route 35 northbound during construction.

Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution and expect delays when driving through the work zone.

This work is part of a \$11.6 million state funded maintenance project that will reconstruct concrete, as well as mill and pave, on approximately three miles of Route 35 northbound between Middleton and Hazlet, Monmouth County and on approximately two miles of Route 440 northbound between Woodbridge and Perth Amboy, Middlesex County. In addition to concrete and pavement improvements on these roadways, the project also includes restriping and some landscaping. This project is expected to be completed by early summer 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
