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Route 1&9 southbound ramp closures tonight as pavement preservation project advances in Newark Motorists advised to follow posted detours

(Trenton) – Route 1&9 southbound is scheduled to have several ramp closures tonight as the Route 1, International Drive to Raymond Boulevard pavement preservation project advances in Newark, Essex County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Monday, October 28 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, October 29, Route 1&9 southbound is scheduled to have several ramp closures to apply a high-performance thin overlay (HPTO) pavement preservation. Only one ramp will be closed at a time. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detours. The following ramps are scheduled to be closed tonight:

- Route 1&9 southbound to Wilson Avenue
- South Street eastbound and westbound ramps to Route 1&9 southbound
- Route 1&9 southbound to Route 21 northbound
- Route 21 southbound to Route 1&9 southbound

This work is part of the \$5.5 million federally funded Route 1, International Drive to Raymond Boulevard Pavement Preservation Project. This project will preserve approximately three and a half miles of pavement. The project is expected to be completed in fall 2024.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
