Garden State Parkway southbound ramp to I-280 closed this weekend for bridge repairs in East Orange Traffic will be detoured using Central Avenue/CR 508

(Trenton) – The Garden State Parkway southbound ramp to I-280 is scheduled to be closed and detoured this weekend for bridge repairs in East Orange, Essex County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 1 until 5 a.m. Monday, November 4, the Garden State Parkway southbound Exit 145 ramp to I-280 is scheduled to be closed and detoured. Traffic at the top of the ramp will be directed to continue straight toward Central Avenue. The closure is necessary for repairs to the bridge over the Parkway, and is part of a New Jersey Turnpike Authority project.

Motorists may want to consider alternate routes. The following detour will be in place:

Garden State Parkway southbound Exit 145 ramp to I-280 Detour:

- Motorists taking the Garden State Parkway southbound Exit 145 wishing to take the ramp to I-280 will be directed to continue straight on the ramp toward Central Avenue/CR 508
- Merge onto South Oraton Parkway
- At the traffic signal, turn left onto Central Avenue/CR 508
- Turn left onto South Grove Street
- Turn left onto the ramp to I-280

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
