Route 30 eastbound to be closed for emergency gate repairs on Bridge over Beach Thorofare in Atlantic City Safety gate damaged in crash this morning

(Trenton) – Route 30 eastbound is scheduled to be closed tonight to make emergency repairs to the safety gate on the Route 30/Absecon Boulevard Bridge over Beach Thorofare in Atlantic City.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, November 6, Route 30 eastbound is scheduled to be closed for emergency repairs to fix the safety gate on the Bridge over Beach Thorofare. The repairs are necessary following a crash on Route 30 eastbound that damaged the gate this morning. Route 30 westbound will remain open, but there may intermittent closures for bridge testing. The repairs are expected to be completed before Thursday morning rush hour. The following detour for Route 30 eastbound will be in place:

Route 30/Absecon Boulevard eastbound Detour:

- Motorists on Route 30/Absecon Boulevard eastbound wishing to take the Route 30
 Bridge over Beach Thorofare to Atlantic City will be directed to turn right onto South
 New Road/Route 9 southbound
- Turn left to take the Atlantic City Expressway eastbound into Atlantic City

<u>Or</u>

Turn left to take Route 40/Route 322/Black Horse Pike eastbound into Atlantic City
