## Route 47 alternating traffic Monday on Bridge over Menantico Creek for gas main installation in Millville, Cumberland County Alternating traffic expected to continue for approximately one month

**(Trenton)** – Route 47 northbound is scheduled to be closed on Monday on the Bridge over Menantico Creek with alternating traffic maintained on Route 47 southbound in Millville, Cumberland County.

From 12 noon to 3 p.m. Monday, December 2, and continuing daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday for approximately one month, alternating traffic will be maintained on Route 47 southbound on the Bridge over Menantico Creek. The alternating traffic pattern is necessary to install a gas main underneath Route 47 northbound. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays while driving through the work zone.

This preliminary utility work is being done in advance of the larger Route 47 Bridge over Menantico Creek Bridge Replacement Project, which is expected to be advertised and awarded in spring 2025. The utility relocations need to be completed on the bridge before the larger bridge replacement project can start. NJDOT will release more information prior to the start of construction.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
