Route 82/Morris Avenue reopened in both directions following watermain repairs in Union Township Ramps from Route 22 to Route 82 and Ingersoll Road also reopened

(Trenton) – Route 82/Morris Avenue was reopened in both directions last night following the completion of emergency watermain repairs near the Lowes shopping center in Union Township, Union County.

Route 82/Morris Avenue was reopened in both directions at approximately 9:45 p.m. on Monday, December 23. In addition, the ramp from Route 22 eastbound to Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound and the ramp from Route 22 westbound to Ingersoll Terrace reopened around the same time. The road and ramps were closed following a watermain break on Tuesday, December 17 near the Route 22 overpass and the entrance to the Lowes shopping center in Union Township. New Jersey American Water and its contractor worked around the clock to locate the break and repair the watermain.
