## **I-295 southbound lane closure tonight for emergency bridge repairs in Lawrence, Mercer County Federal City Road westbound ramp to I-295 southbound also closed tonight**

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the right lane on I-295 southbound is scheduled to be closed tonight for emergency repairs to the Federal City Road Bridge over I-295 in Lawrence, Mercer County. In addition, the ramp from Federal City Road westbound to I-295 southbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured.

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Friday, February 21 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, February 22, the right lane on I-295 southbound is scheduled to be closed before the Federal City Road Bridge over I-295 near milepost 71. At least two lanes will be maintained.

In addition, beginning at 9 p.m., tonight, Friday, February 21 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, February 22, the ramp from Federal City Road westbound to I-295 southbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured. The closures are necessary for emergency repairs to the bridge, which was struck by a truck carrying construction equipment on Wednesday afternoon. The following detour will be in place:

### **Federal City Road westbound to I-295 southbound Detour:**

- Motorists on Federal City Road westbound wishing to take the ramp to I-295 southbound will be directed to continue on Federal City Road
- Turn right onto Ewingville Road
- Turn right onto Route 31 northbound
- Take the ramp to I-295 southbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
